

WHITE LINER

Route Map from International Terminal to Domestic Terminal

Please use the escalator or elevator located between Departure Gates C and D to get to our 1F White Liner Domestic Tour Desk Counter.

Careful! Use only the escalator or elevator as indicated by ○. Escalator or elevator indicated by ✕ will NOT connect you to our White Liner Domestic Tour Desk Counter.

Go in the opposite direction (④→①) if going from domestic terminal to international terminal.

- ④ Use only the escalator or elevator in front of JAL Departure Gate D



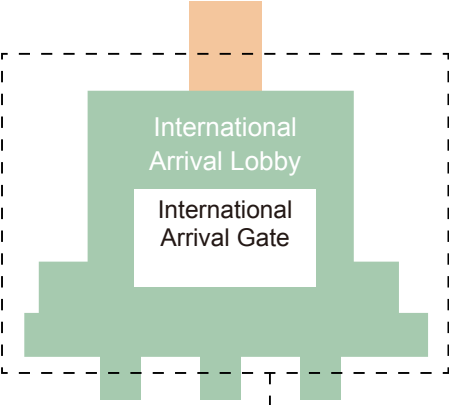
Do NOT use this Center Plaza elevator.

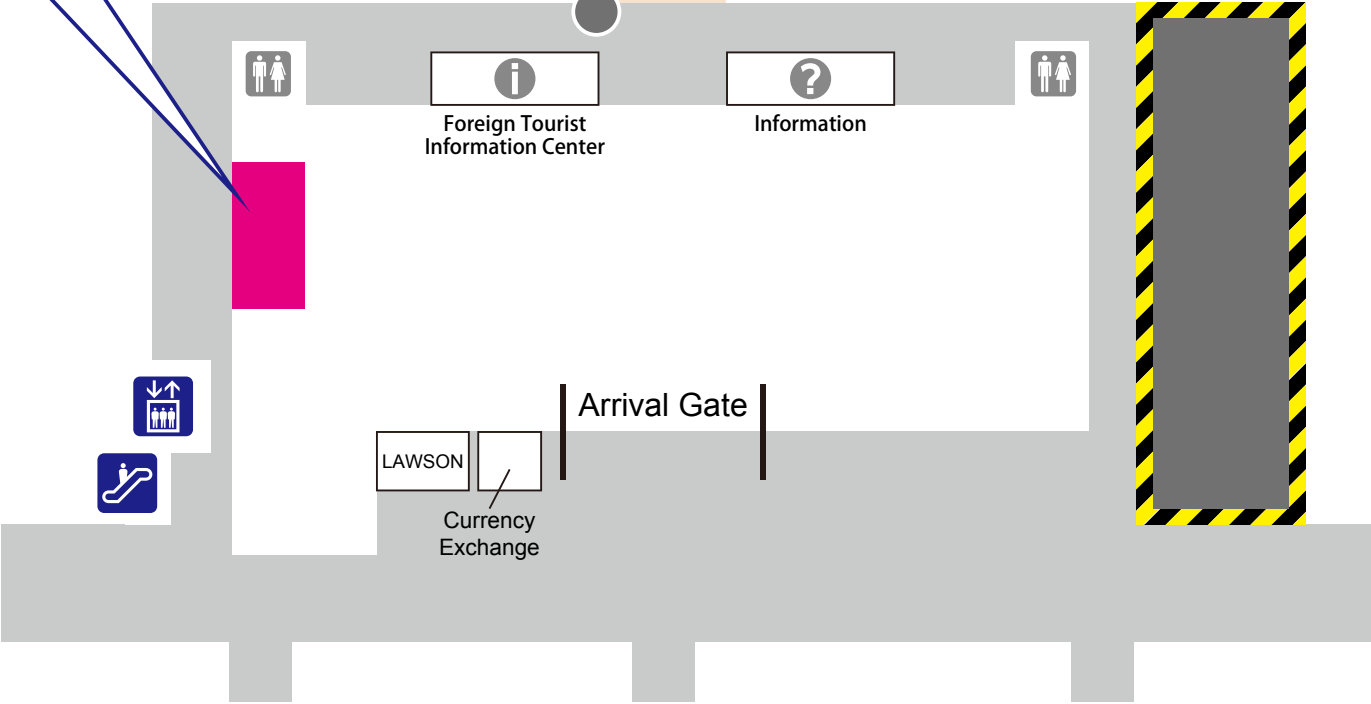
New Chitose Airport Terminal 2F

Walk along the Connecting Passage to Domestic Terminal (Departure Gate C)



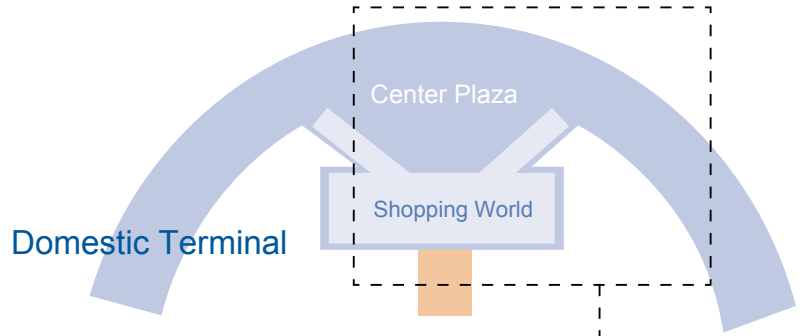
